# TROPICAL RAINFORESTS & WHERE THEY ARE FOUND

- Tropical rainforests are found between the Tropic of Cancer and the Tropic of Capricorn.
- This area is called the Tropics.
- They are found in Africa, Australia, Central America, South America, Southern Asia and the South Pacific Islands.

# 4 FACTS ON TROPICAL RAINFORESTS

- 1. The Amazon Rainforest is tropical .**
  - If it was a country it would be the 9<sup>th</sup> biggest country in the world.**
- 2. The average temperature of Tropical Rainforests ranges from 70 to 85°F (21 to 30°C).**
- 3. The humidity is really high year round (77% to 88%).**
- 4. Yearly rainfall ranges from 200 to 1000 cm.**


# TROPICAL RAINFORESTS ANIMALS



- **Forest Floor= Okapi, Tapir, Sumatran Rhinoceros, Western Lowland Gorilla.**
- **Understory layer= Jaguar, Poison Dart Frog, South-American Coati, Boa Constrictor.**
- **Canopy Layer= African Gray Parrot, Keel-Billed Toucan, Spider Monkey, Three-toed Sloth, Kinkajou.**
- **Emergent Layer= Crowned Eagle, King Colobus, Large Flying Fox.**



# TEMPERATE RAINFORESTS & WHERE THEY ARE FOUND

- Temperate rainforests appear in costal regions outside the tropics
- They can appear away from costal areas in rare circumstances.



# 4 FACTS ON TEMPERATE RAINFORESTS



1. Temperate rainforests receive between 152.4 and 508cm of rain every year.
2. They have a dry season and a long wet season.
3. In the summer it can get quite hot and in the winter it can get near freezing.
4. The largest temperate rainforests are in North America and run along the coast.

# TEMPERATE RAINFORESTS ANIMALS

- **North America= Moose, Elk, Black-tailed deer, American Black Bears, Owls, Skunks, Muskrats.**
- **Asia= Siberian Tiger, Snow Monkeys, Snow Leopards, Eastern Leopards, Brown Bears.**
- **Europe= Brown Bears, Wolves, Ibex, Stoats, Hares, Wild Boar, Elk, Lynx.**

**These animals also live in sections of the rainforest (Forest Floor, Understory Layer, and Canopy Layer).**



# 3 SIMILARITIES BETWEEN TEMPERATE & TROPICAL RAINFORESTS

1. They both get lots of rainfall year round and are very lush and wet.
2. They both have species of animals not found in regular rural areas or urban areas.
3. Trees and plants are very, tall and green in both.

# 4 DIFFERENCES BETWEEN TEMPERATE & TROPICAL RAINFORESTS

1. Tropical rainforests get more rainfall than temperate rainforests and tropical rainforests are more lush and wet as well.
  2. Tropical rainforests have more species than temperate ones.
  3. Temperate rainforests are located to the north and south of the tropics unlike tropical ones, which are in the tropics.
  4. Tropical rainforests have a warmer climate than temperate ones due to higher humidity.
