# Music Department Policies 2016/2017

## THE STUDENT'S RESPONSIBILITY

- Arrive to school with correct books and music bag on scheduled day for lessons
- Complete all writing work as assigned
- Listen and cooperate during the lesson, following the instruction of your instrument teacher
- Maintain a positive and respectful attitude
- Give any communications that are sent home to parents/guardians
- Practice at home as required by your instrument teacher

## THE PARENT'S RESPONSIBILITY

- Support the student to establish a consistent practice routine that is free from distraction
- Encourage your child to complete all assignments each week
- Check your child's Practice Journal weekly to ensure that you are aware of practicing and theory expectations, and to look for correspondence from their instrument teacher
- Ensure your child has a music bag (supplied by the school) to bring their music books and materials to their lessons every week
- Contact their instrument teacher or Ms. Armitage if there is a concern
- Ensure your child brings all their materials to each lesson otherwise valuable lesson time will be wasted photocopying material
- For younger and beginner children parents/guardians are encouraged to assist their child's practicing. If you have any questions on how you can assist your child do not hesitate to talk to your teacher or attend a lesson

# **CANCELLING A LESSON**

If a child misses a lesson due to absence from school, unfortunately due to time constraints, this lesson cannot be made up. If a lesson is missed for another reason i.e. a school trip we will endeavour do our best to make up this lesson however this **CANNOT** be guaranteed. It is the parent's responsibility to inform the relevant instrument teacher or Ms. Armitage that their child will be absent from a lesson due to an upcoming school trip or event, **NOT** the class teacher. A lesson is considered forfeited if a student does not wish to attend for a scheduled lesson.

### SWAP LIST

It is NOT the responsibility of the instrument teachers to organise 'swapped' lessons for students. A Swap List will be available this year for parents/guardians of students who attend private lessons. Parents who wish to be part of the Swap List will agree to have the following information listed on the Swap List :

- 1) Their name and email contact details
- 2) Their child's name and lesson time

Once the timetable is drawn up by Ms. Armitage the Swap List will be distributed to all parents who are on the list. If a situation arises where a student is unable to attend their scheduled lesson time for any reason, the parent can contact other parents on the Swap List to see if anyone is able to 'swap' a lesson day/time. Parents are asked to try to swap with students who have the same length lesson. Once a swap has been arranged it is important to let the instrument teacher know. If a swap cannot be arranged and a student cannot attend at their scheduled lesson time the lesson will be forfeited.

#### **INSTRUMENTS**

St. Andrew's College cannot take responsibility for individual instruments, it is therefore the responsibility of the parent/guardian to ensure their child's instrument is named and taken care of. Lost instruments owned by the school must be replaced by the parent/guardian.
